About Us

Croydon Coin Auctions is a "Bricks&Mortar" auction house selling a wide range of coins, medals, banknotes and other items in Croydon, South London, recently celebrating its 25th year.

Their first sale was held on 4th March 1983 at Croydon Parish Church Hall. Since this first auction of 610 lots there have been over 200 regular sales. It is now on its third location - having spent several years at the South Park Hotel, sales are now held at the United Reformed Church in Addiscombe Grove. Our website, available at www.croydoncoinauctions.co.uk, provides details for forthcoming sales, photographs of selected lots and details of previous sales including their realised prices.

The Sale

Sales are now held at the United Reformed Church Hall. Situated in Addiscombe Grove, in Central Croydon this venue is easily accessible to all forms of transport:

The sale begins at noon, with viewing available prior to the sale from 9:30am.

Train: 150 yards from East Croydon Station, which serves Victoria, London Bridge (15-17 mins), Blackfriars, King's Cross Thameslink (17-25 mins) Watford Junction, Luton, Bedford, Brighton, Gatwick Airport, Bognor, Portsmouth etc.

Tram: 150 yards from East Croydon Tramstop serving Wimbledon, Beckenham Jct, Elmers End, New Addington.

Buses: 150 yards from East Croydon bus station, routes 64,119,130,194,197,198,312,367,410,466,726,T33.

Also serving Central Croydon:50,60,75,109,154,157,166,250,264,289,403,407,409,412,468,494

Car Parking: Available in Hazledean Rd,. Pay/display around Blake Rd all within 250 yards. There is free parking on Northampton Road, further along Addiscombe Rd, about a ten to fifteen minute walk away. There are frequent buses & trams along Addiscombe Rd.

Condition of Sale

1. The highest bidder shall be the buyer and the auctioneer's decision is final in any dispute.
2. The auctioneer has absolute discretion to divide, combine or withdraw lots, to refuse bids and to regulate the bidding.
3. All lots put up for sale are subject (a) to any reserve imposed by the seller and (b) to the right of the seller to bid personally or through any other person.
4. All grading and description of lots will be undertaken by the auctioneer. Each lot is believed genuine (unless stated) but should any lot prove not to be as described the purchaser may return the lot in its original condition within 15 days of the sale. Purchasers having attended or viewed the lot may not subsequently reject any lot by reason of its grade or otherwise unless the item is not genuine, or has been altered so as to deceive.
5. Where notice of rejection has not been given (by telephone, recorded/registered post, or fax. Email is not secure and is used at the buyers risk - proof of sending will not be taken as proof of delivery.) within 15 days of the sale then the item is considered sold. Safety and costs of return are at the purchasers risk and registered post should be used.
6. Lots described with defects may not be rejected due to these defects.
7. Postal and other remote bids (eg. through the website, email) will only be accepted on multiple lots on the understanding that any lot not fully described will not be subject to the usual approval terms.
8. Buyers must satisfy themselves as to the accuracy of their purchases at the time of viewing and/or delivery. The auctioneers will not be responsible for any discrepancy after the lot(s) have left their custody.
9. Successful postal bidders will receive a statement of account as soon as possible after the sale. The full remittance including delivery charges should be forwarded within 5 days. The lots will then be forwarded by the auctioneers on approval unless payment is late (please review conditions 4 and 5 for time limits). Cheques from new clients will need to be cleared. Please allow 7 days.
10. The auctioneers only act as agents between the vendor and purchaser and will not be liable for any dispute which may arise between them,
